Eligibility and Requirements

- Must be an enrolled medical student, preferably with 3 years of medical education.
- Must be in good academic standing at your medical school.
- Clearly define your learning objectives. Admission priority will be given to those in clinical clerkships.
- Communicate proficiently in English or Mandarin Chinese.
- Possess a basic understanding of Chinese culture and resilience to culture shock.
- Must comply with laws and regulations in China during the visit.

Checklist of Application Documents

Please submit the following documents when applying our clerkship program:

- Curriculum Vitae
- Student Clerkship Application Form
- Transcript or a Letter Confirming Good Academic Standing (waived if applying through a clinical department within PKUPH)
- 1 Letter of Recommendation from Your Institute (preferred but not a must)

The following documents should be submitted before your clerkship at PKUPH:

• Proof of Clean Criminal Record

*Please note that if you have difficulty obtaining the proof, you may alternatively sign the *Criminal Record Declaration* provided by PKUPH.

- Photocopy of the Passport/ID Card Photo Page
- Peking University People's Hospital Student Clerkship Agreement
 *Please note that this agreement will be signed by three parties: you, your university and PKUPH.
- Proof of Medical/Accident/Travel insurance (preferred but not a must)
 *Please ensure that you have valid personal insurance. If accidental injuries occurred during the clerkship, PKUPH shall not be held liable to pay compensation for the injuries caused.
- Immunization Proof (preferred but not a must)
